Update on the impact of our work at Qualified Listeners:

Through July 2019

- 180 Listening Sessions
 - o 262 hours
 - o 10,510 miles
 - o 77% are Veterans
 - o 32% are female
 - o 12% are spouses
 - o 39% served in combat
 - o 7% were abused as children
 - 418 total Listening Sessions since we started the program in May 2017
- We're currently working on 12 active projects for Veterans & families
- 5,400 Veteran & Family Resource Directories distributed since we started the program in April 2018
- We're proud to directly serve over 100 Veterans or family members each month


