# **Impact Report**

Update on the impact of our work at Qualified Listeners:

# **Through June 2019**

- 151 Listening Sessions
  - 0 214.5 hours
  - o 9,274 miles
  - o 78% are Veterans
  - o 31% are female
  - o 11% are spouses
  - o 55% served in combat
  - o 8% were abused as children
  - 389 total Listening Sessions since we started the program in May 2017
- We're currently working on 15 active projects for Veterans & families
- 5,200 Veteran & Family Resource Directories distributed since we started the program in April 2018




Easterseals Northern Colorado Services is excited to offer Independent Community

The Back Home SSVF Program is a Housing-First program designed to deliver case management, temporary financial assistance, and other support services (such as employment/education assistance) to Veteran families. Examples of services provided include:

- Case management
- Housing search counseling/assistance
- Education/employment counseling
- Temporary financial assistance (limited as indicated by VA depending upon the type)
- Advocacy
- · Referrals to community resources

Our services are designed to "prevent and resolve homelessness".

To receive supportive services under the SSVF program, you must be:

- 1. A Veteran
- 2. Extremely low income
- 3. Homeless or at immediate risk of becoming homeless
